Michelle Rose teaches a variety of courses, including visual communications, computer aided drafting, residential interior design, senior Capstone, and professional practice. After teaching at Appalachian State University in North Carolina, Michelle Rose moved back to her home state of Mississippi in the fall of 2005, and has continued her teaching career at the University of Southern Mississippi.

Michelle Rose received her Bachelor of Science degree in interior design in 1991 from The University of Alabama. She pursued a career in interior design, with a focus on residential design and retail marketing. In 1999, Rose returned to the University of Alabama and received a Master of Science in interior design in 2001. During her time as a graduate student at the University of Alabama, Rose focused her research in the area of universal design, taught the introduction studio to applied design, and developed an interior design resource database. After graduation, Rose worked in Acworth, Georgia, producing rendered perspectives, orthographic drawings, and other illustrative materials for residential and commercial developments.

In 2005, Rose completed her Educational Specialist degree in instructional technology at the University of Tennessee, during which she continued to work as an interior designer and teach at Appalachian State University in Boone, North Carolina. During her studies at the University of Tennessee, Rose developed a web-based student resource instructional tool for undergraduate students studying interior design, and was awarded membership in Phi Kappa Phi honor society. Rose is also a member of the Interior Design Educators Council (IDEC), the American Society of Interior Designers (ASID), the International Interior Design Association (IIDA), the National Kitchen & Bath Association (NKBA), the Mississippi Coalition for Interior Design Legislation (MCIDL), and the United States Green Building Council (USGBC), a NCIDQ certified interior designer, and currently serving as the faculty advisor for the Interior Design Student Association (IDSA), including the Southern Miss student chapters of the American Society of Interior Designers (ASID) and the National Kitchen & Bath Association (NKBA).
